

# ROTHSAY PUBLIC SCHOOL – HYBRID LEARNING PLAN

## JUNE 11, 2021 UPDATE

\*If Rothsay school goes to a hybrid plan, following are the plans:

### COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

- Parents and students will be notified of a change to hybrid learning by JMC notification, email, and schoolinfoapp.
- Major communication will be done by the same means.
- The documents associated with hybrid learning will be posted on our website.
- Provide parents with Summit contact information for mental health needs.

### NUTRITION

- Students will be able to access school lunches and breakfasts at school.

### INTERNET AND DEVICE ACCESS

- We will continue to survey our parents and do everything in our power to be sure that all students have WiFi access and that all students grades 3-12 have a chromebook.
- Loffler will continue to provide support for those computers.

### ROTHSAY SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Social distancing of six feet between students in classrooms.
- Plexiglass barriers in the office.
- Disinfectant wipes in each classroom.
- Disinfectant wipes in random locations.
- Each classroom will be disinfected during the day.
- No large assemblies.
- Video conferencing with parents whenever possible. Examples would be conferences and IEP meetings.
- Eat in “pods”
- HS students will eat in shifts with and “A” and a “B” lunch.
- Students will be given a handwashing break (at a minimum) in the morning and afternoon.
- Provide parents with Summit contact information for mental health needs.
- Students kept in same grade “pods” during classes, if possible.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

### **Safe Routes**

- Bus at 50% capacity or less

### **Safe Drivers**

- When sick, stay home

### **Safe Ride**

- ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD or DRINKS passed around or consumed on the bus

### **Bus Garage**

- Each bus will be disinfected after each route
- Seats, driver area, entry handrail, entry door area, clean break areas constantly, clean restrooms constantly, and encourage good hygiene
- Discourage community donuts, snacks and other food and keep hanging out to a minimum.

## **MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING**

- Parents will contact the school counselor or Summit if your child is experiencing mental health problems.

## **STUDENTS RECEIVING SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES**

- Rothsay school will continue to follow the IEP.

## **ATTENDANCE AND MEMBERSHIP**

- Attendance will continue to be kept.

## **GRADING**

- Grading will continue to be the traditional A-F

## **MASTER SCHEDULE**

- High School students will follow their regular schedule – room assignments may change to accommodate social distancing.

## **IN THE EVENT OF A COVID-19 CASE/EXPOSURE**
